Additional information about St. Anne's Trivia Night

How the game is played:

There are ten rounds of questions, with ten questions asked in each round.

Each round has a category. The categories are announced at the beginning of the evening. Categories cover a wide-range...there is something for everyone!

Each team is provided with ten answer sheets (one for each round). Each answer sheet has answer blanks numbered 1 through 10 (to correspond with each question).

All questions are delivered orally or by playing a recording.

Team members may confer with one another before writing down their answer; however, any use of reference materials or electronic devices during a round is prohibited.

After all ten questions have been given, teams will be given a brief period to request questions to be repeated before the round is ended. No requests to "clarify" questions will be honored.

At end of the round, an announcement is made that answer sheets must be turned in to the official scorers. Answer sheets that are not turned in promptly may be disqualified.

Answers must be written legibly. The decision of the scorers is final. For each correct answer, a team is given one point.

After all rounds are completed, the team that has the best total score, wins.

Mulligans:

A mulligan is a "credit" for a wrong answer. When a mulligan is used, the team will get a point despite having given a wrong answer. Teams are limited to five mulligans and only one mulligan per round may be used. (A mulligan is "wasted," if used in a round that the team correctly answers all the questions.) Mulligans will be sold before the start of the game. Mulligans will cost \$10 each, or five for \$40.

Tie Breakers:

Before the game is started, each team is asked to write down an estimate of their total score. The team whose estimate more closely matches their actual score, wins the tie. The other team places behind.

Trivia prizes:

Prizes will be awarded to the top three trivia teams (as determined by total points). Each member of a winning trivia team will receive a "like" prize.

Table decoration prizes:

Prizes will be awarded to the team whose table is judged to be best decorated and most fitting to the theme of "One Hundred Years of the University of Memphis." Each member of the winning team will receive a "like" prize.

UofM memorabilia prizes:

A 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place prize will be awarded to the winning individuals who bring the best item or collection of items pertaining to the University of Memphis.

Door prizes:

Each team member will be eligible to receive a door prize by filling out a ticket. At least two door prizes will be awarded after each round, rounds one through nine.

Refreshments:

Free soft drinks and popcorn will be provided. Teams may bring their own drink of choice, as well as additional snacks. Teams may also bring their own ice chests.

Location:

This event will be held in the gym on the campus of St. Anne Catholic Church and School, 706 South Highland. The gym is located on the eastside of the property. There will be free parking on the church's lot, but only a limited number of spots are available. Entrances to the parking lot are on Spottswood and Kearney.

Time:

Doors will open at 6pm that evening. (Team members arriving before 6:30 will be eligible for additional prizes.) Registration will close at 7pm and the game begins immediately following. Each round is expected to last approximately 10 to 15 minutes. There will be a short break (15 minutes) between rounds five and six.

Miscellaneous:

Beginning after round two, the answers to the previous round will be given. Throughout the evening, each team's current score will be displayed. Teams will be identified only by a number. Smoking is not allowed in any part of the building. Each team will be seated at a round table (4' in diameter). A team may choose the location of their table on a "first come, first serve" basis.
