Carmelite Prayer

Every Christian prays. But, what is prayer? Prayer at its essence is *an interaction with God*. It can be done alone or as a group. The thoughts can be original or thousands of years old. It can be verbose or entirely wordless.

God is *always* communicating with us. He is telling us how much He loves us through nature, our friends, our sufferings, and our daily tasks.

Carmelite spirituality emphasizes *listening*. You could say, Carmelites pray with their ears. They try to increase the space in their hearts and minds to sense God's subtle movements, even when they're externally active. Lay Carmelites also make time for God giving Him undivided attention and sitting with Him to listen whether He has anything to say right then or not.

Carmelites pack their hearts with scripture and liturgy, so that God has plenty of good material to work with. They don't expect original compositions. Carmelites ruminate over His Word day and night, waiting for Him to move their hearts with a word. He may draw attention to daily life or reveal some new depth of His charm. But very often, He says nothing at all and enjoys the time together.

May we all take time daily to listen to God in the many ways He speaks to us
