From its beginning, Carmelite spirituality has placed a strong emphasis on reflecting over scripture. The Rule of St. Albert stresses that God's Word in the Bible must have a central place in our lives. Eight times the Rule tells us to read the Bible. We are told to "Ponder the law of the Lord day and night" and that "the sword of the Spirit, the Word of God, must abound in your mouth and your heart."

Lectio Divina, or holy reading, is a traditional method of praying over the scripture where we let go of our own ideas and let God speak. We open We open ourselves to what God wants to say to us. Through praying the Scriptures we let God's Word penetrate our hearts so that we may grow in an intimate relationship with the Lord who must become the most important Person in our lives.
