Lectio Divina- In the 12th century a Carthusian monk, Guigo, described the four stages he saw as essential to the practice of lectio divina. These stages are:
1)lectio or reading, 2)meditation-meditation, 3)oratio-prayer and 4)contemplation-rest.

These stages are not fixed rules but simply guidelines as to how prayer normally progresses. The movement of prayer is towards greater simplicity with less talking and more listening.
