LAY CARMELITE NEWS:

The first Carmelites lived as hermits on Mt. Carmel. When in the 13th century, they moved into Europe, they became friars. This meant they were called to serve God's people in an active apostolate. Unlike some religious families, Carmelites are not dedicated to a particular way of service. Carmelites, instead, simply respond to the needs of Christ and the world. These needs differ according to time and place. Therefore, the service a Carmelite is involved in differs according to the needs of the people around him and his/her own particular talents. Lay Carmelites, too, are called to serve. The St. Anne Lay Carmelite community assists our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society by providing bags of toiletries for Christmas baskets. In addition, our individual members are involved in their own areas of service. That may be caring for the ill or elderly, leading prayer groups, serving in our parishes.
