Monday: 3 am, 4am, 5am, 7am, 11am, 11 pm

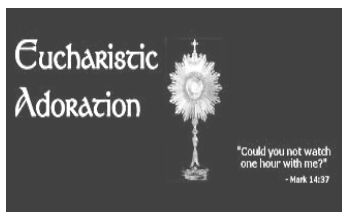
