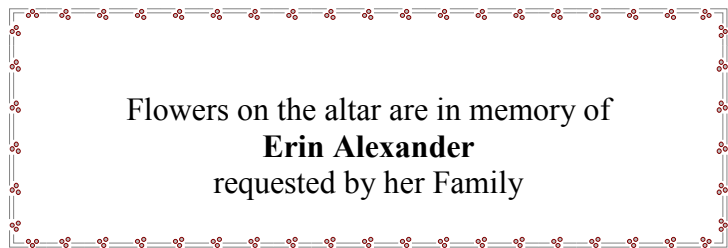

- (2) Make a modest donation benefitting the Ozanam Center.


