## PRE REGISTRATION ANNOUNCEMENT 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

It is time to register your children for Parish Religious Education Classes for the new school year. Classes will begin on September 30 and be scheduled on Sundays from 1:00 p.m. to 2:20 p.m. We will distribute a schedule of the classes for the coming year on the first Sunday of class.

We must have the registrations complete by **September 9**, in order to arrange the classes and order materials.

Registration fee is \$30 per year for one child; \$50 for 2 children; \$75 for 3 or more children.
