## PRE REGISTRATION ANNOUNCEMENT 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

It is time to register your children for Parish Religious Education Classes for the new school year. Registration fee is \$30 per year for one child; \$50 for 2 children; \$75 for 3 or more children.
