PRE REGISTRATION ANNOUNCEMENT 2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

It is time to register your children for Parish Religious Education Classes for the new school year. All children in the parish who are not attending a Catholic School should be enrolled and participate in the Parish Religious Education Classes. If they do not attend the classes, your children will not be able to receive First Communion and/or Confirmation.

Registration for the classes will end this Sunday, **September 9**.

Classes will begin on September 30 and be scheduled on Sundays from 1:00 p.m. to 2:20 p.m. We will distribute a schedule of the classes for the coming year on the first Sunday of class.

We must have the registrations complete by **September 9**, in order to arrange the classes and order materials.

Registration fee is \$30 per year for one child; \$50 for 2 children; \$75 for 3 or more children. Brendy Enriquez will be present on registration Sundays after Mass at the registration table in the vestibule of the church to help you complete the registration. We are going to do everything we can to make this a good experience for you and your children.
