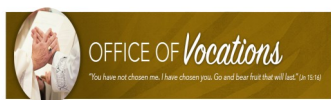
Through your generosity the SVDP conference at St. Anne's is privileged to serve 100 to 140 families or individuals each week with food, MLGW or rent assistance.
