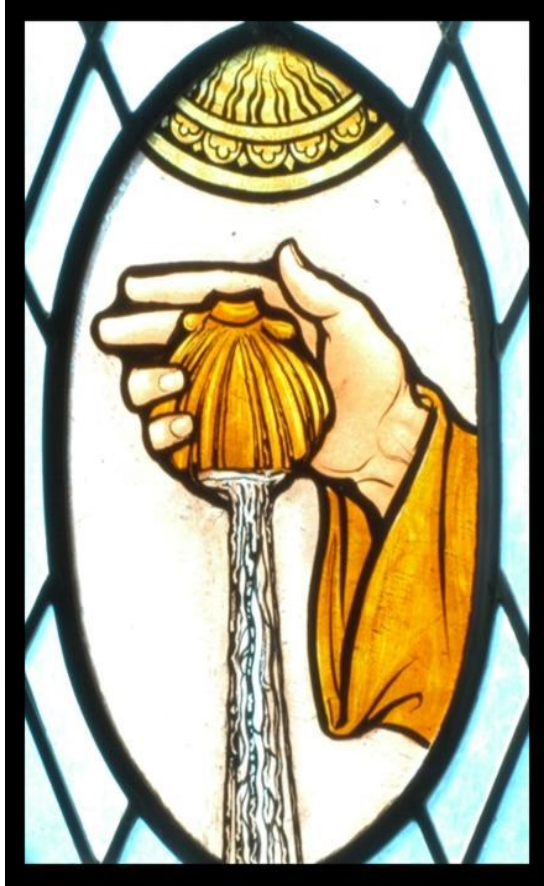
### ALTAR SERVERS NEEDED
