**Through your gifts, the Society of St. Vincent de Paul was able to help the poor celebrate the peace of Easter.**

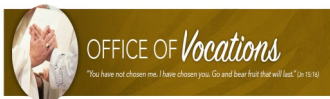
Through your generosity the SVDP conference at St. Anne's is privileged to serve 100 to 140 families or individuals each week with food, MLGW or rent assistance.
