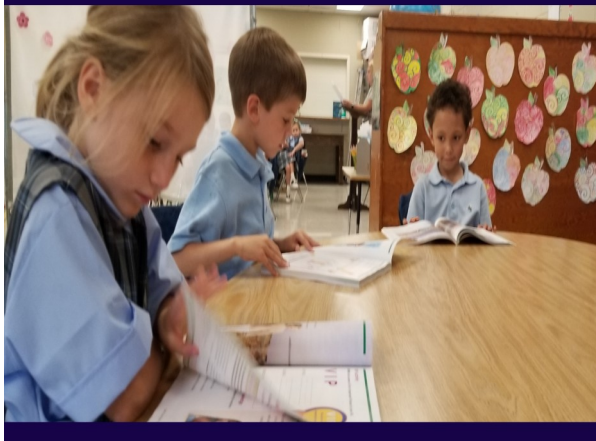
Deanery-Wide Consecration to Jesus through Mary
