## St. Vincent de Paul Annual Report for Year Ending September 2020

The Society of St. Vincent de Paul, a Catholic lay organization, invites women and men to join together to grow spiritually by offering person-to-person service to those who are needy and suffering in the tradition of its founder, Blessed Frederic Ozanam, and patron, St. Vincent de Paul. St. Anne's Conference consists of ten (15) active members and eleven (4) associate members who meet twice a month to pray and to plan their work.

Food is now being distributed from the Pre-school building every Saturday between 9am and 11am. The Society also provides emergency financial assistance, usually to individuals or families facing eviction or termination of utilities. Financial assistance is provided to local area residents only after thorough interviews have been conducted through home visits.

This year our conference received:

\$ 2,086.00 from "secret collection" taken up from active members at regular meetings  
\$ 5,623.00 Other SVdP Contributions  
\$40,938.00 from contributing members/parishioners (church & poor box collections)  
\$48,647.00 total collected income for the year Oct. 2019 - Sept. 2020  
\$ 2,774.00 balance on account from previous year ending Sept. 2019  
\$51,421.00

Money disbursed as follows:

\$ 410.00 was spent in operating and miscellaneous expenses  
\$ 1,657.00 Solidarity dues and contributions to District Council  
\$ 1,450.00 Disaster contributions and twinning with other conferences  
\$ 45,849.00 was spent in financial assistance, mainly for rent or utilities, to 660  
Individuals and families and also funded our Food  
Pantry which distributed over 7158 bags of groceries throughout the year.

Your St. Anne Conference was responsible for approximately 700 telephone contacts and 79 home visits. Our members spent approximately 900 hours and logged approximately 400 miles in the course of these services. Our food pantry was staffed by a minimum of three volunteers every Saturday throughout the year. We currently have 3 rotating pantry crews comprised of members and volunteers. During the year we have been blessed with new members, but unfortunately, some have seen the need to resign. Anyone who feels God is calling them to service in this worthy mission of charity, please contact one of our officers or members. Due to Covid 19, our meetings have been subject to change. Meetings are normally held every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday of each month at 6:15 in the Joachim Center. Check the Church bulletin for any changes.
