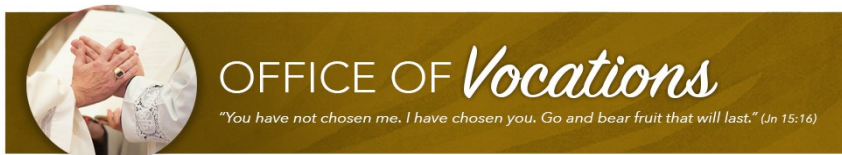
Our Memphis Diocese and Knights of Columbus Partner to Present the Angelo Luchessi Seminarian Dinner 2022 in July.
